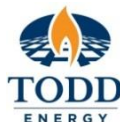

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KEY HIRE INFORMATION

For Lease Key Holders

CLUB RULES & PROCEDURES FOR PRACTICE & TESTING

The following are the KartSport Taranaki Club Rules and Procedures regarding Practice and Testing.

Members who lease a key can access the track to carry out tuning or practice. Persons using the track must be full club members holding either a KartSport New Zealand Practice Licence, Vintage Licence or Full Competition Licence and must comply with KartSport New Zealand and KartSport Taranaki Safety Rules and Regulations.

Track Hours:

9.30am to 5.00pm (Winter time)

9.30am to 6.00pm (Daylight Saving time)

A fine may be imposed on any offender using the track outside these hours.

Track Rules:

- All standards of safety gear must be worn when driving a kart on the circuit (i.e. KartSport New Zealand approved helmet, suit, gloves and footwear)
- For safety reasons no mixing of classes - Cadet, Junior Restricted, Junior and Seniors are to be 'tuning' separately, at all times.
- All karts are to travel in the same direction on the circuit with a maximum of 10 minutes per 'tuning' session when other classes are also waiting to use the circuit.
- Entry onto the circuit is from the Dummy Grid through the pit gate and exit from the circuit by karts is down the Pit Chute only and stopping at the designated point. NO karts are to be driven in the Pits.
- When practicing in the Clockwise Direction on the track, the pit gate must be shut once the karts leave the grid for safety reasons.
- When tuning at the track, another person is to be available to render assistance in the case of an Accident or drive an injured person to medical help. For any accidents that require medical assistance, a report has to be given to a KartSport Taranaki Risk Management Officer Maurice Frost, 0274403835 to cover ACC requirements. If the accident is serious call 111 then call either Steve or Maurice immediately
- Please ensure Entry/Exit Gate is locked once you enter.

Upon completion of 'tuning', toilets must be left clean, the premises locked, tyres across the track must be locked and the pits left clean and tidy. Exit/Entry gate must be locked as you leave.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in forfeiture of the key.
