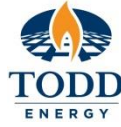

I/we agree to fully indemnify Kartsport New Zealand Incorporated, Kart Sport Taranaki Incorporated, FIA-ClIK, Motorsport New Zealand Incorporated, the New Plymouth District Council, all sponsors (including but not limited to Todd Energy Limited, TSB Community Trust and Taranaki Electricity Trust) and all or any members, officials or assistants, servants, representatives or agents of any of the aforementioned organisations, from all losses or liability suffered by them as a result of any death or bodily injury, loss or damage which may be sustained or incurred by myself/ourselves or my/our invitees, as a result of my/our use of the Club's facility (including private use for practice) howsoever such death or bodily injury, loss or damage is caused, notwithstanding that such death, injury, loss or damage may have been contributed to or caused by the negligence of Kart Sport Taranaki Incorporated or any of its respective officials, servants, representatives or agents or by any other person. Track Hours:

9.30am to 5.00pm (Winter time) 9.30am to 6.00pm (Daylight Saving time)

A fine may be imposed on any offender using the track outside these hours.

Track Rules:

- All standards of safety gear must be worn when driving a kart on the circuit (i.e. KartSport New Zealand approved helmet, suit, gloves and footwear) For safety reasons no mixing of classes - Cadet, Junior Restricted, Junior and Seniors are to be tuning separately, at all times. All karts are to travel in the same direction on the circuit with a maximum of 10 minutes per tuning session when other classes are also waiting to use the circuit. Entry onto the circuit is from the Dummy Grid through the pit gate and exit from the circuit by karts is down the Pit Chute only and stopping at the designated point. NO karts are to be driven in the Pits. When practicing in the Clockwise Direction on the track, the pit gate must be shut once the karts leave the grid for safety reasons. When tuning at the track, another person is to be available to render assistance in the case of an Accident or drive an injured person to medical help. For any accidents that require medical assistance, a report has to be given to a KartSport New Zealand Senior Race Official, to cover ACC requirements.

Please ensure Entry/Exit Gate is locked once you enter.

Upon completion of tuning, toilets must be left clean, the premises locked, tyres across the track must be locked and the pits left clean and tidy.

Exit/Entry gate must be locked as you leave.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in forfeiture of the key.
