Sorry for the delay in getting this newsletter out to you all. Since Christmas and the holidays, I seem to have barely had time to catch my breath before realising that we are now into mid-February!

There have been a few things going on so hang on tight while I rattle my brains to try and get them onto paper. Personally, the biggest event for Team Boniface has been the CIK Trophy of NZ, so it got me to thinking about getting our members to tell me of anything significant that may have happened for you over the last couple of months. It doesn't matter if it seems insignificant to you or not. It may be that you set a new personal best while practising at the track or an event? It doesn't even need to be karting related, but I'd love to hear your thoughts.

### 2013 CIK Trophy of New Zealand, Wellington

Congratulations to the eight Taranaki drivers and crews who travelled to Wellington to contest the CIK Trophy of New Zealand last weekend. All the drivers did well with their driving and results. The weather was hot and the track was challenging as always.

The following results were obtained:

Thomas Boniface (Cadet) won the event, collecting his first National title after a blistering qualifying effort to be second fastest, only 0.096s behind Ben Morrison of Mt. Wellington. He followed this up with 3 great drives in the heats to place his Kiwi Kart on pole position for the prefinal. Following a 3rd place in the pre-final, Thomas started the final well, snatching the lead after corner two for the 18 of the 19 laps to take victory. The race was very intense, with the chasing karts applying relentless pressure on him. fantastic effort by Thomas and he deserved his win.

Blake Evans drove hard all weekend and showed great speed at times. He qualified 8th fastest and finished 4th in the pre-final. Blake finished 5th overall, but was promoted to 4th following the DQ of Joshua Parkinson.

**Hunter Cheetham** had a mixed weekend and also had great pace after such a short time in the JR class. He qualified 5th but was unfortunate

to place 14th in the pre-final. He drove a great final to finish 8th overall from almost the rear of the field.

**Dylan Frere** drove very well, but was unfortunate to suffer engine and clutch issues which hampered his efforts. Dylan, Charles and Lydia can be very proud of his final position of 11th, ending the 19 laps only 11.338 seconds behind winner, Liam Lawson of Mt. Wellington. Dylan has found some real speed in his kart, and will surely be one to watch in coming events.

Matthew Podjursky was in good shape and looking very competitive in the KF3 on Friday during unofficial practice, but the engine suddenly suffered some terminal damage and was sidelined. Luckily, Matt was able to swap classes and run in Junior Yamaha instead. The bad news was his engines had not been freshened as they didn't think there would be a need to run them. Matt battled away, qualifying 18th fastest and then started the pre-final from grid 10. He finished the final in 7th and was promoted to 6th following a DQ for Jordan McDonnell from Christchurch.

**Sebastian Bainbridge** had a weekend to forget, qualifying 19th but crashing on lap 5 in the pre-final. Starting from the rear, he also crashed on the first lap in the final, completing his weekend in 20th position.

Brad Still drove very well, qualifying 2nd fastest behind Alex Geary by 1/10th of a second. Alex was looking very fast and very smooth as always. Brad was still experimenting with the setup of the new Tony Kart and more speed is sure to come. Following the heats, Brad ended up on pole position for the pre-final and Alex was to start from 4th on the grid. These positions were to stay the same during the pre-final and became the grid positions for the final race. The final was a good battle, with Ryan Cappleman taking the race win, with Brad 2nd and Alex moving up to 3rd.

An awesome weekend of hot and dry weather (totally out-of-character for Wellington!) and some awesome racing took place. The event will be screened in two programmes on TV3 CRC Motorsport.


### <u>Supreme Kart Supplies WPKA</u> Goldstar Series

### It's Technical (Kartsport NZ stuff)

Permits Dept - The Permits Department will be closed from 16 Feb to 4 March (inclusive) while the Permits Manager is on holiday.

Race Officials Seminar - KartSport New Zealand held a two day Grade 1 and 2 Race Officials Seminar in Wellington over the weekend of 9/10 February. Race Officials from most areas of New Zealand were in attendance and all benefited from the opportunity to interact with their fellow officials.

A highlight of the weekend was a video analysis session of actual racing incidents with insight from two of our ACADEMY Coaches, Niki Urwin and Daniel Kinsman. Other sessions covered event race management, roles of officials, mentoring and the issue of the updated training modules. The seminar concluded with a session Sunday afternoon on Communication and Relationship Management which was facilitated by an external professional trainer.

The entire weekend was aimed at providing an enhanced level of training for our officials at Grade 1 and 2 to ensure collective understanding and consistency.

In summing up at the end of the weekend, all in attendance agreed that the seminar had been successful and of great value to them all.



# Rule Changes Issue 2013-1 have been published. These include:

- New Rotax Max Crankcase and Chain/Clutch Guard.
- Clarifications regarding latest CIK-FIA homologated bodywork and intake Silencers.
- Clarification regarding Gearbox/Gear case overflow bottles.
- Clarification regarding rear bumper height.
- Clarification regarding use of the Blue & Red Double Diagonal flag.
- Clarifications regarding fuel & tyre testing levies.
- Clarification regarding event programmes.

Competitors and guardians are reminded that drivers can only practice in a class of kart which is allowed for their respective age. See Rules E3 and Q5.1 for details.

If you wish to keep your Competition Licence Number you need to keep your Licence current. This is especially applicable to senior competitors holding a one or two digit licence number.

When sending your Licence for renewal please ensure you use the current Application Form, include your valid Club Membership Card and your complete old Licence/Log Book. Both will be returned to you with your new Licence/Log Book. Failure to include these will delay processing and cause added administration time/cost. Please fill out your Application Form clearly, especially your email address which is normally our key means of contacting you and sending you E-Line.

One Day Licences are limited to 5 in 12 months.

Licence Declarations are only for those competitors who leave their Licence at home or have lost their Licence. Licence Declarations are not available for when a Licence is in transit. Licences in transit – if the event Race Secretary does not hold an email from KartSport New Zealand advising that a Licence is in transit, the competitor will be required to complete another Licence application and pay the relevant fees to the Club. These will be forwarded after the event by the Club to KartSport New Zealand and if a Licence is being held or has been returned the 2nd payment will not be processed.

**Event Indemnities** – These must be signed even if a Change of Guardian Form is being used.
