## Proposed Summer and Winter Series changes

There have been some changes proposed to alter the current Winter and Summer Series structure, as well as address what appear to be unfair penalty points. Some discussion has been had around these issues and a couple of options for change have been developed, as below. Some of the current problems are:

- The Summer Series spans two different calendar years, meaning the prizegiving is at least 6 months behind the existing prizegiving date
- The Winter Series is awarded over 12 months after the end of the series in following calendar years due to the timing of the series, as are the trophies for the Enduros.
- The Enduros are always held in marginal weather, so there is a plan to shift these
- The current penalty points are too harsh for someone who may miss a meeting for a legitimate reason, ending their chance of winning a trophy and potentially quashing their enthusiasm to come and race again until the start of a new series
- It is thought that the current structure involves too much racing which can conflict with other events (National events, Goldstar, Rotax Max Challenge, Pro Kart, Top Half, Blossom etc.) and reduce the chance that members will race at club days. Do we in fact drop a club day in July completely or have a fund/technical day?

Therefore, the following couple of options have been put forward. If you would like to debate the proposal, feel free to come along and have you say at the AGM on 24 August. We are happy to hear any discussion on the issue.
