

Please ensure you understand this, as these are the rules. Said club member(s) will be removed from the track and their key will be withdrawn...this is not negotiable.

The power boat one is funny or ironic—don't know if it ever happened then, but it is 46 years later.


Note from minutes - 20th October 1968
